

Well Baby and Child Visit

The Nurse-led Well Baby & Child Visit program is designed for families who are patients of the Trent Hills Family Health Team.

The first goal of the program is to prevent illness through assessment, immunizations and education on nutrition and child development.

Our second goal is to support families adjusting to life with their child. This will be done through early detection of deviations in child development, post-partum depression screening and providing links to appropriate community services for families.

What the Well Baby & Child Visit Program can do for your family:

- Assessments & Screening
- Discuss parental concerns
- Nutrition education and breastfeeding support
- Immunizations
- Referral and link to other healthcare and community services
- This program will provide families with well baby/child care, education and support.

What can I expect?

The program includes a series of check-ups at two, four, six, twelve, fifteen, eighteen and thirty-six months as well as 4-6 years of age.

At each visit, the Registered Nurse will:

- Measure and weigh your child
- Assess your child's growth according to his/her age
- Provide immunizations according to the Ontario Immunization Guidelines
- Work in collaboration with your family Doctor or Nurse Practitioner
