**If you need a prescription renewed, including early renewals,** call your pharmacy and ask them to fax it to us.

## **Covid-19 Vaccinations**

Children ages 5 – 11 now eligible for their Covid vaccinations.

Our Campbellford clinic will provide COVID-19 vaccinations for anyone 12 years and older, including those eligible for third doses. Please call your doctor’s office to book.

## **Third Doses**

Anyone who is aged 18 years or older is now eligible for a third dose, **3 months** after their second dose.

## **Vaccine Exemptions**

THFHT physicians will write a letter of vaccine exemption only under the following circumstances:

1. You have **documented proof** of an allergy to an ingredient in the vaccine, i.e. from an allergist.

**OR**

2. You have **documented proof** of a severe reaction to the first dose of the vaccine.

If proof of either of the above is not already in your chart, you will need to provide the documentation to be added to your chart.

**There are NO other circumstances under which they will write a letter of exemption.**

**Please note:** Administrative staff and nurses follow this directive and cannot make exemptions.

Any harassment or verbal abuse of either the staff or the nurses WILL NOT be tolerated.

## School Children with Covid-19 Symptoms

A child is required to stay home from school if they have any of the following symptoms:

- fever
- cough, shortness of breath
- nausea, vomiting, diarrhea
- decrease or loss of sense of taste or smell

### Before returning to school, these are the options:

1. get a COVID swab and isolate until they have a negative result
2. stay isolated at home for 10 days from onset of symptoms. They may return after 10 days if they have no fever, and symptoms have been improving for at least 48 hours
3. get an alternate diagnosis from MD (example, allergies)
